# Darwin Super 7's Rules 2017

## 1. Pitch

- 1.1. Pitch dimensions are approximately 60m x 40m.

## 2. Teams

- 2.1. A maximum of eleven (11) players may be registered per team,
- 2.2. A maximum of seven (7) players are to be fielded, per team, at any one time with unlimited interchange,
- 2.3. Each team must field a minimum of five (5) players otherwise the match will be deemed a forfeit with points awarded to the opposing team,
- 2.4. Mixed, U13s and U15s are mixed gender Divisions. Mixed Division teams must field at least two female Players at all times whilst U13s Division and U15s Division must field at least 1 female Player at all times, and
- 2.5. Mixed Division teams may only field a maximum of two (2) Mens Division Players at any one time. A breach of this rule is a red card offence. In this instance, the opposing team must select a player of the offending team to receive the red card.

## 3. Players

- 3.1. All players must be registered with FFNT prior to playing in the competition proper,
- 3.2. Each player may be registered to more than one (1) team but no more than two (2) teams, and
- 3.3. Players playing in the Mixed Division must be a minimum of 14 years of age or turning 14 years in the year of play.

## 4. Referees

- 4.1. The referee has full control and authority over the game. Fouls and misconduct are as per International Federation of International Football (FIFA) Laws of the Game. Red and Yellow cards may be issued during this League,
- 4.2. Interchange must be made at halfway, and
- 4.3. No Assistant Referees will be provided.

## 5. Match Day

- 5.1. No jewellery shall be worn onto the field of play (FIFA Laws of the Game),
- 5.2. All players shall wear approved shin protection at all times throughout a match (FIFA Laws of the Game),
- 5.3. Team members shall wear matching shirts and goalkeepers shall wear a shirt that distinguishes them from outfield Players (FIFA Laws of the Game),
- 5.4. Indirect free kicks shall be applied for the attacking team for any free kick offence by the defending team within the penalty area,
- 5.5. Penalty kick rules are the same as 11v11 rules. All players, except the defending goalkeeper, shall remain behind the ball until a penalty kick is taken,
- 5.6. Goalkeepers have 4 seconds to throw the ball or play it off the ground, no drop kicks or punts shall be allowed.
- 5.7. The back-pass rule shall be the same as the 11v11 rule (FIFA Laws of the Game),
- 5.8. Throw-ins shall be taken from the appropriate spot on the side line (FIFA Laws of the Game),
- 5.9. Goal kicks may be taken from anywhere within the penalty area (4 second time limit),
- 5.10. No offside, and
- 5.11. All finals matches shall go straight to penalty kicks after normal time to determine a winner. The players on the pitch at the conclusion of full time are the only players eligible to take a penalty kick.

## 6. Fees

- 6.1. A non-refundable administrative fee of \$20 shall be payable upon submitting a Team Nomination Form,
- 6.2. Players must be registered with competition administrators prior to registering online,
- 6.3. Player registration fees are as follows;
  - 6.3.1. U13s Division and U15s Divisions Players: \$95,
  - 6.3.2. Womens and Mixed Divisions Players: \$110, and
  - 6.3.3. Mens Division Players \$130.
